

#### Suns Charities to Provide Breakfast to Students

As part of the "SunsCentral" partnership, Phoenix Suns Charities' board members and Suns' employees will hand out healthy breakfast packs to more than 1,200 students taking the AIMS test at Central High School on Monday and Tuesday (February 25 and 26). The packs will be distributed on both days between 7:15 – 8:15 a.m.

The healthy breakfast packs will be donated in an effort to increase the number of students receiving a nutritional breakfast and enhance testing performance. Each pack will contain a Nature Valley granola bar and fresh fruit, as well as a water bottle, pencil and an encouraging note from Suns' guard, Kendall Marshall. The snack packs are being made possible by a \$20,000 grant to Phoenix Suns Charities from General Mills along with product, in addition to a generous donation of fruit and water by Fry's Food Stores.
